

ATTENDED FUNERAL (FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S CHARGES ONLY) **£2,255**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements. **£700**

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care. **£250**

Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises. **£195**

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak wood effect. **£495**

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer). **£20**

At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle. **£595**

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only) £1975

Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)² £2302

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents from: £1,016

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**.

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is **£785 – £1,095**

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICE

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile) **£2.00**

Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer) **£195**

Collection and delivery of ashes **£1**

Embalming **£125**

Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.). **Prices on request**

Services supplied outside of normal office hours. **Prices on request**

Arranging and attending to the interment of ashes **£75.00**

Taking your loved one to rest at home or church prior to the funeral service on a weekend or Bank Holiday **£350.00**

Additional funeral directors charge for weekend bank holiday funerals **£500.00**

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.
